Mrs. Mary Buschman was one of the very aged persons in this locality, died at her country house south of Minster last Monday, May 5, 1930, near the hour of midnight. She was born in this section of Ohio and fate permitted her to continue to live among the people of the community over a period of four score of years. The last two decades of her life were attended with much affliction and she was not permitted to assume obligations nor to render large service as long her condition when her body was strong.

Twenty-four years ago Mrs. Buschman was overcome by a paralytic stroke and the effects of that unfortunate accident persisted with her from that time until the end of her life. Her condition, immediately after the stroke, seemed to be grave but as time passed by she regained her strength and lived over a half a century of a century. However, she required some special attention because she never fully developed the use of her body as it was previous to the time when the trouble manifested itself.

Mrs. Buschman was the eldest of the late Frank Buschman, who died seven years ago at the same place where the death of Mrs. Buschman occurred. He was a farmer by occupation and was recognized as a very successful operator in the line of his work. He and Mrs. Buschman reared a delightful family of nine children, most of them in good times.

Mrs. Buschman was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Godfrey Hoying who were residents in the Egypt community many years ago.

Mrs. Buschman was a member of the St. Augustines Catholic congregation and contributed to its efforts among the people.

Mr. and Mrs. Hoying, parents of Mrs. Buschman, had several children in their household, but the family became extinct with the passing of Mrs. Buschman.

Mr. and Mrs. Buschman became the parents of nine children, one of whom passed away many years ago. Eight are living and they are: Mrs. Elizabeth Stueve who resides on the farm where the parents first established their home; Mrs. Mary Stueve, at Osgood; Joseph Buschman at home; William Buschman, at Minster; Rose, Henry and Gertrude Buschman at home; Fred Buschman, at Minster. She is also survived by ten grand children, sixteen great grand children and one great great grand child.

The funeral is to be held at St. Augustines church in Minster this Friday morning at 9:30 o'clock and the body will be interred in the local cemetery.

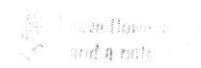
