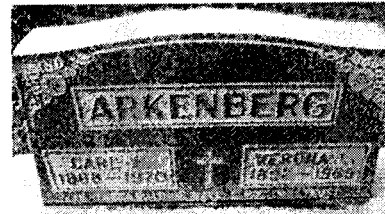
Born in New Bremen, July 21, 1892, she was a daughter of Edwin and Flora Wissman Jung.
