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MINSTER — Eight Minster High School students, on their way to a dance at the Carousel Ballroom near Celina, were killed and three others injured after being struck by a car last night at 8:10 as they stood on the Minster-Fort Recovery Road, about four miles west of here.

The youths, on their way to a Catholic Youth Organization dance, had decided to change their route in order to stop by the home of a Maria Stein basketball player, Howie Overman, to tout Minster's Saturday night victory at a sectional finals game.

Also visibly injured was the driver of the car which hit the youths, John Kremer, 21, R.R. 2, Maria Stein, who was reportedly not treated.

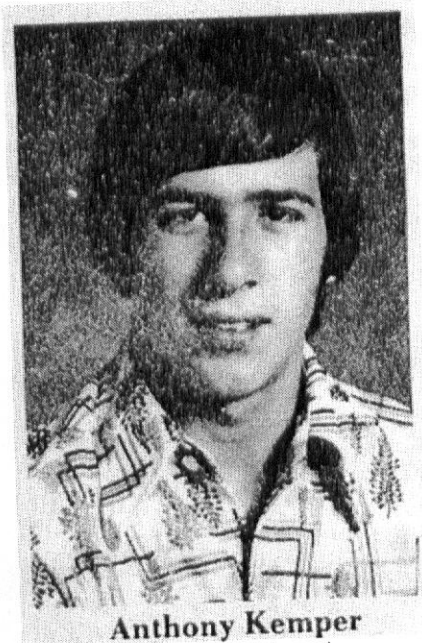

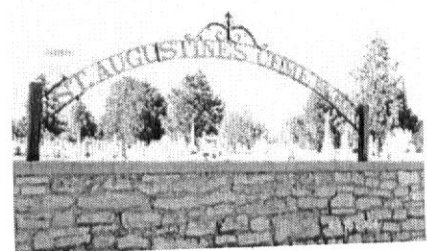
