## FORMER MAYOR OF CELINA DIES

## Patrick E. Kenny Was Oldest Mercer-co Attorney

CELINA, Nov. 29 — Patrick E. Kenney, 92, oldest Mercer-co practicing attorney and former mayor of Celina, died at the Otis hospital at 9 a. m. Thursday where he had been a patient a week and a half. He suifered a heart atlack earlier and had been removed to the hospital.

He was born in Cincinnati and had been a resident of Celina virtually all his life. He attended law school in Valparaiso, Ind., and Ohio Northern university, Ada. Prior to becoming an attorney he taught school in the Indiana Irish settlement.

Following his law school training he became associated with the firm Leblond, Leblond and Loughridge in Celina and in 1887 was admitted to the Ohio State Barassn.

He was elected prosecuting attorney of Mercer-co for two consecutive terms and later mayor of Celina for two consecutive terms after which he assumed the senior partnership of the fum Kenney and Hinders.

His wife, Caroline Schmidt, preceded him in death in 1932. He was a member of the Church of the Immaculate Conception in Celina and of the Holy Name and Poor Souls societies of the church. Also, he was a charter member of the Celina Council of Knights of Columbus.

Surviving are a son, Grover J. Kenney, Los Angeles. Calit; and two daughters. Claudia, a reacher in Celina public schools, and Mrs. Jerome W. Grothjean, also of Celina, and four grandchildren.

Requiem high mass will be celebrated at 9.30 a.m. Monday in the Church of the Immaculate Conception with Rev. Albert Gerhardstein as celebrant Interment will be in the mausoleum of the church cemetery, with arrangements in charge of the Pulskamp funeral home in Celina.
