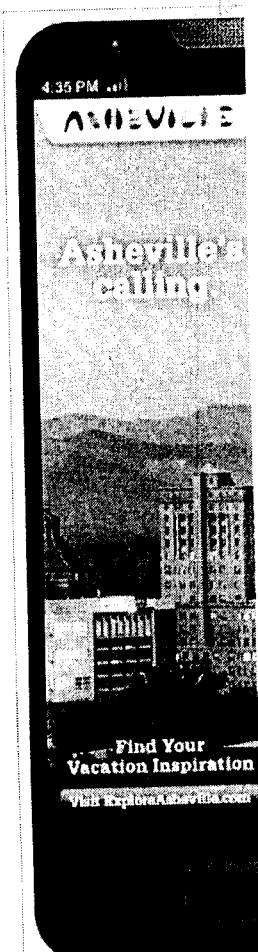

Onetime Mercer Commissioner Dies

MINSTER—Requiem High Mass will be sung in St. John's Church at Maria Stein at 9 a. m. Thursday for Anthony Kleinhenz, 78, a lifelong resident of that community, who died at 6:40 a. m. Monday in Mercy Hospital at Coldwater following a two weeks' illness of a heart ailment. The Rev. George Kraft will officiate and burial will be in the church cemetery.

Mr. Kleinhenz, a business man in Maria Stein for many years, served as Mercer County commissioner from 1944 to 1948 and served 12 years as a member of the board of the St. John Local School District. He was a member of the Knights of St. John and a member of the St. Joseph Society of the church.

Surviving are his widow, Anna Lochtefeld Kleinhenz, to whom he was married in 1914; seven sons, Joseph, Maria Stein; Paul and Harold, both of St. Henry; Walter, Dayton; Stanley, St. Marys; and Thomas and Andrew, at home; two daughters, Mrs. Cornelia Heitbrink, Dayton, and Mrs. Andrew Brumby, Celina; 11 grandchildren; three sisters, Mrs. Mary Fleck, Dayton, and Mrs. Regina Meyer and Mrs. Minnie Kleinhenz, both of Minster.
