Kohnen and Henry Kohnen who died in 1925. After his return from the war fronts he was employed by the Frank Morsey & Sons poultry firm until 1936, when he entered the veterans' hospital and was a patient there five months. He entered the hospital again 10 days before his death, which occurred suddenly when his mother and two brothers were visiting him.

He is survived by his widow, Frances Weiskittel Kohnen, whom he married Feb. 22, 1927, and the following children: Merilyn, 16; Lois, 14; Henry, 12; George, 11; Dennis, 6; Karen, 18 months; two brothers, Charles and Andrew, and a sister, Mrs. Ralph Paepplman, all of Minster.
