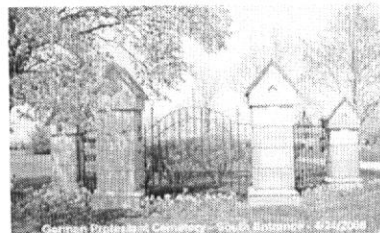
MRS. WITTENBRINK

The beautiful life of a well-known and highly respected woman was brought to a close Saturday morning with the death of Mrs. John H. Wittenbrink, who died at her home on North Herman street following an illness of several months. Mrs. Wittenbrink long took an active interest in the religious life of the community and through her church work became endeared to all who knew her. She attained the age of 60 years, 10 months and 9 days.

Mrs. Wittenbrink, formerly Miss Martha Mary Kuenning, was a daughter of the late Frederick and Wilhelmine (Schulhoff) Kuenning and was born January 19, 1865, on what is now known as the Frank Kuenning farm, north of town. She received her early religious training in St. Paul's church where she was confirmed during the pastorate of Rev. C. Heise. Her marriage to Mr. Wittenbrink occurred on June 14, 1883. Mr. and Mrs. Wittenbrink lived for a time on the Wittenbrink homestead but later moved to New Bremen and for the past 30 years resided in the present Wittenbrink home on North Herman street.

Surviving members of the immediate family are the husband, John H. Wittenbrink; one son, Harry F. Wittenbrink, Cincinnati; two daughters, Mrs. Ed Schunck, Minster, and Mrs. Roy Huckeriede, New Bremen; and four grandchildren, Mary Ellen Wittenbrink, Kathleen Schunck, and Frederick and Earl Huckeriede. Mrs. Wittenbrink also is survived by three brothers and three sisters, George Kuenning, Columbus; Otto Kuenning, Lima; Frank Kuenning, Mrs. Henry Luobkeman, Mrs. Herman Blanke and Mrs. Henry Grolwe, New Bremen.

Friends of the family were permitted to view the body Monday evening at the late residence. Funeral services in charge of Rev. J. C. Melchert were conducted at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon in St. Paul's church. Burial was had in the German Protestant cemetery. [N.B. Sun - 12/3/1925]
