## Ben E. Lampert

Farmer, Livestock Dealer

Funeral services were conducted in St. Augustine's Church Thursday morning for Bernard E. (Ben) Lampert, aged 48 years and 11 months, farmer and livestock dealer, who died early Sunday in Golden hospital at Celina from a heart attack and resulting complications, after an illness of six days. Burial was made in the church cemetery.

Rev. Theodore Rogien was celebrant of a solemn high mass offered with Rev. B. V. Haller as deacon and Rev. Robert Wines as subdeacon. Military honors were accorded Mr. Lampert, a veteran of World War I, with the American Legion in charge of services at the grave.

Mr. Lampert was taken to the hospital Monday after suffering a severe heart attack. Paralysis of his left side developed almost immediately and a blood clot formed. His condition was serious during the entire time of his illness.

A native of Minster and a son of Bernard and Anna Pauwell Lampert, he was born June 6, 1895, one-half mile north of Minster on the present J. C. Vello farm. He resided in this community until 1936 when he transferred his residence to New Bremen, residing on a farm at the outskirts of that village.

He was married to Bernadine Lininger in 1920 and she died in 1938. He was married a second time, to Mary Lininger of St. Marys, in 1940. His widow survives, with the following children from the first marriage: Orville Lampert, New Bremen; Virgil, at home; Thomas, with the armed forces in England; Miss Marilyn, Eugene and Miss Audrey, at home.

Surviving also are his mother, who resides on North Main street with her son, Cleve; a grandfather, Beverly Lampert; a sister, Mrs. Caroline Bernman, Minster; and three brothers, Andrew Lampert of Wapakoneta and Alfred and Cleve of home. A son died in 1931; a brother, Charles, was claimed in 1926 at the age of 30, and his father preceded him in death in 1931. (Minster Post - 5/5/1944)
