Saturday morning the Death Angel called Charles Lampert, and bore his spirit to his Maker. He was aged 31 years, 6 months and 21. days, and had fived his entire life in Minster.

He was a willing worker, of good habits and very friendly toward his fellow man. He was of a quiet disposition, tending strictly to his own business, and let others tend to their own, which, in itself, was an admirable trait, worthy of emulation by many others.

He had been slightly ailing for several months, nothing serious until Sunday of last week, when he was taken with hemogrhage of the nose. He was bedfast from then until his demise. Saturday morning. His death is attributed to complications resulting from an attack of influenza, about a year

Fof several years he was in the employ of The Aughize Cooperage & Lumber Company, and they speak in words of praise of his connection with them. He was a member of the Catamet Fire Co., and always did his duty.

He leaves his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Lampert, four brothers, Andrew, Bernard, Alfred and Cletus Lampert, and one sister, Mrs. Carrie Bensman, one brotherin law, Louis Bensman.
