Kate Herkenhoff

Mrs. Katherine [Kate] Herkenhoff, 83, native of Minster, died at 6:30 p. m. last Friday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Frank Sommers of Northwood, Celina R. R. 4, after a lingering illness due to a complication of ailments.

Born Nov. 2, 1873 she was the daughter of Joseph and Marie Landwehr. In February of 1891 she was married to A. W. Herkenhoff in Chicago. He died April 17, 1947.

Her husband was prominently associated with the cooperative business in Minster and had served the village as its mayor for four terms.

Mrs. Herkenhoff was a member of St. Augustine Church in Minster and the St. Monica Ladies Sodality.

Solemn requiem high mass was celebrated Monday at 10 a. m. in St. Augustine Church, with Rev. William Meyer the celebrant. Interment was made in the church cemetery.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Lillian Sommers and Mrs. C. A. [Beatrice] Boesel of Duluth, Minn.; five grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. There is also a brother, Joseph Landwehr of Minster.

One son, Alfred Herkenhoff, a daughter, Mrs. Mabel Brandts, and two grandchildren, Frank and Vera Sommers, preceded her in death.
