[N.B. Sun - 9/30/1910] Mrs. Maria Wilkelmina Kuenning, nee Schulhoff, departed this life on Sunday evening of this week after a several months illness with cardiac asthma, at the age

of 71 years, 2 months and 23 days. Deceased was born in Shelby County on July 2, 1839. In 1856 she was married to Gerhard Lan-fersieck, who died in 1862, the union having been blessed with four children, two of whom are still living. In the year 1864 her second marriage took place to H. F. Kunning, the union being blessed with eight children, one daughter preceding the parents in death, Mr. Kuenning being called in July of 1904. After the death of her husband she made her home with her son-in-law, Herman Blanke and family, enjoying excellent health until several months ago, when she was taken ill with the ailment above mentioned and which the best of medical aid Burial could not stave away. took place yesterday afternoon at the German-Protestant cemetery, preceded by special services in St. Pauls church, Rev. W. F. Hen-ninger conducting the last sad rites. The Ladies Aid Society of which she was a charter member, attended the services in a body.


