John B. C. Laut. 85, one of New Bremen's oldest residents, wellknown citizen and last of a group; of seven brothers. Thursday, evening at about midnight died at his home on South Franklin street after four weeks illness following a stroke. His sister, Mrs. Fred Ende is the only survivor of the original Laut family.

He was a native of New Bremen and spent his entire lifetime; in the willage. The son of the late Christian and Katherine Wiegers Laut, at an early age he learned the eigarmaker's trade at which he was active until mechanized shops devotred the business of the hand shops. Then for a number of years he conducted a lunch room and later he was variously occupied until old age caused him to retire. Mr. Laut was an able musician and formerly for many years was the leader of the then famous "Little Six Band" whose services were in demand at many public functions throughcan this section of the state. Sevteral of his brothers were memhers of the band.

November 7, 1878, Mr. Laut married Miss Bertha Kalling, who now survives him with the following children: Mrs. Leonard Jordan, of Toledo; Clarence Laut, of New Bromen; Mrs. Charles Vogelsting, of Columbus; Mrs. Gerald Steinle, of Warren, and Melville Laut, of New Bremen. There are four grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

He was a member of the St. Paul's Evangelical and Reformed church.

The funeral services were conducted Sunday at 2 o'clock from the A. H. Albert funeral home with Rev. J. C. Melchert in charge. Burial in the Willow charge. Grove cemetery.
