

NEW BREMEN — Jeannette M. "Nettie" Bertke, 89, formerly of 120 S. Main St., New Bremen, and a resident of Otterbein, St. Marys, since May 1994, died at 3:15 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 25, 1999, at the Otterbein.

She was born Sept. 2, 1909, at New Bremen to Clarence and Luetta (Speckman) Laut. On June 24, 1931, she married Ray F. Bertke. He died Sept. 23, 1981.

Survivors include brothers Lloyd Laut of the Otterbein, St. Marys, Arnold Laut of Leesburg, Fla.; a sister, Lorraine Blanke of the Otterbein, St. Marys; and a number of nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by a son, Richard Bertke, in January 1952, and a brother in infancy.

Mrs. Bertke was a member of the St. Paul United Church of Christ at New Bremen and a member of the former Christian Services Guild of the Church. A charter member of the New Bremen Senior Citizens where she also taught ceramics. She was a former member of the Auglaize County Farm Bureau. She was a homemaker.

Funeral services will be 11 a.m. Saturday in Gilberg Funeral Home at New Bremen with the Rev. John W. Tostrick officiating. Burial will be in the German Protestant Cemetery at New Bremen.
