Martin Michael Lehmann was s/o John Michael Lehmann and Mary Catherine Mills.

## He married:

(1) Elvera "Vera" Georgia Anna Knostman (1907-1940), in 1929 at St. Augustine Catholic Church, Minster, Auglaize County, Ohio. She died from Bright's Disease. A son, Robert, was born May 1929 to the couple. Robert died December 1929.

(2) Mildred Louise Cotterman (1917-1945); married in 1940 in a civil ceremony, and they were remarried in 1945 at Wilson Hospital, Sidney, Shelby County, Ohio. They were the parents of two children.

(3) Alida Doris (Covault) Bayman (1910-2001), a widow, with two children; married 29 May 1948 at St. Boniface Parsonage, Piqua, Miami County, Ohio. Martin and Alida were the parents of two Lehmann children.

He died from mouth cancer at age 70 years. He was buried 18 October 1975.
