Victim of auto accident died Monday, Nov. 7th.

One of the saddest deaths that happened in this town in years occured Monday, Nov. 7th, when the well known contractor Nicolas A. Ley died from the effects of an auto accident which took place Sunday afternoon on the St. Marys-Ft. Amanda pike.

Mr. Ley was on his return trip home from Convoy in a Ford antomobile, when near the Shipman Farm on the St. Marys-Ft. Amanda pike a dog came in his way. Mr. Ley made a fraitless effort to avoid killing the animal. In righting the machine it went in the read ditch and also struck a pile of crushed stones whereby it turned over. Mr. Ley was pinned under the auto and found unconscious. He was then brought to the Linville undertaking establishment at St. Marys in Luville's ambulance, There the doctors did everything to help the mjured man and Rev. Beckneyer of the Catholic Rosary church administered the hely sacraments. Mr. Ley was then brought to his home in Minster in Linville's ambulance. He did not regain consciousness and lingered away till 10 minutes past four in the morning of Monday when he closed his eyes in death. He had suffered a fracture of the skull on the loft side on a lovel with the eyes; his lower jaw was also broken; besides his arms were badly injured. The auto had a broken windshield, damaged top, hent left front fender and a crippled stoering wheel.

Nicolas A. Ley was born in the neighborhood of Versailles, Darke County, in the year 1861 on Decomber 31st, a son of Mr. Emanuel J. Ley and wife Mary Catherine. He grow up in that community. When 14 years of age he moved with his parents to Minster where he since that time had made his home. He later entered the temberstone business and became a building contractor of note doing expecially much work at Lima.

In the year 1855 he was married to Miss Philomena Stimmer of Minster the marrings ceremony taking place in the St. Augustinus church. To this marringe were born 9 children one of whom died in infancy and 8 are surviving, as follows: Mrs. Helen Schaefer, Celina, Mary Loy at home, Catherine, Anna and Adelena Loy at Dayton, Emma, Theodore and Andrew Ley, Minster. Catherine Ley, the brothers Louis and Joseph, the latter in California, also one son-in-law, Mr. Joseph Schaefer of Celina and 3 grandchildren. Mrs. Ley proceded her husband in death on Oct. 13th, 1914.

Mr. Loy was of a quiet disposition attending to his business and to the family. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and also belonged to the St. Boniface Benevolent Society and the St. Augustine Orphan Society of the St. Augustine church, the members of which attended the faneral in a bedy. He reached the age of 54 years, 10 months and 5 days.

The funeral took place Thursday morning, Nov. 9th at \$:30 o'clock at Minster. The family of the deceased have the sympathy of the whole community in their and bereavement.
