Mrs. Rose Runkle Of Dayton Dies Tuesday

Mrs. Rose Runkle, 79, of Dayton, a native and former resident of Minster, died Tuesday at her home. She had been ailing since the time of an auto mishap in May of this year.

Mrs. Runkle was born in Minster Oct. 23, 1883. She married Ben Grothjan, who preceded her in death. She married James Jacobs, who died in 1927, and she outlived her third husband, Nathaniel Runkle.

She is survived by seven children, namely Mrs. Howard (Louella) Randolph of Dayton, Mrs. Vernon (Pearl) Behm of Minster, and Wilfred Grothjan of Flint, Mich., all from her first husband, and the following from her second husband: Mrs. William (Leora) Bauser and Mrs. Charles (Roberta) Detmer, both of Dayton; Melvin Jacobs of Minster and Mrs. William (Eileen) Long of Dayton. A son, James Jacobs, is dead.

There are three sisters and a brother, namely Delia Ussendorf and Mrs. George Meyer, both of Dayton; Mrs. Walter Price of Brookville and LeRoy Ley of Minster.

Funeral services and burial are tentatively planned for Friday in Dayton. The body is at the Tobias Funeral Home in that city.
