Roy May, 89, formerly of 625 E. Spring St., St. Marys, and a resident of Otterbein St. Marys Retirement Community, died at 9:15 a.m. Aug. 24, 2004, at Joint Township District Memorial Hospital, St. Marys.

He was born Jan. 1, 1915, in New Knoxville, to John and Bertha Wierwille May. On Sept. 20, 1947, he married Rosalinda Berning who survives.

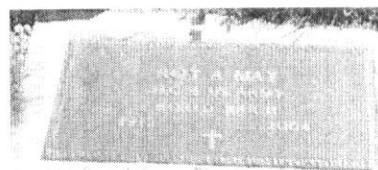
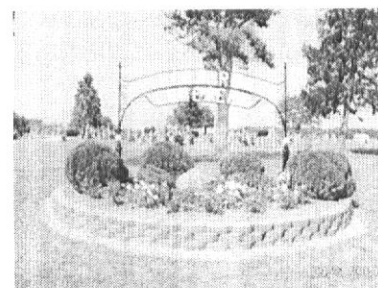

He won numerous state and national tournaments as a left-handed golfer and was instrumental in starting junior golf leagues in Minster and St. Marys.
