Solemn Requiem High Mass was sung in St. Augustine's Church at 9 a. m. Monday for Frances Elizabeth Ritter, aged 74 years, of 45 South Lincoln Street, widow of Joseph Ritter, who died at 10:45 p. m. last week Wednesday in Mercy Hospital at Coldwater from effects of a paralytic stroke suffered April 20.

Celebrant of the mass was the Rev. Donald Thieman. Assisting as deacon and subdeacon were the Rev. Bernard Felix of New Bremen and the Rev. Aloysius Cook. Burial was made in the church cemetery.

A lifetime resident of this community, Mrs. Ritter was born on a farm east of Minster May 7, 1882. Her parents were John H. and Katherine Ripploh Meyer. She and Mrs. Ritter were married Aug. 22, 1906 and he preceded her in death a year ago. She would have observed her 75th birthday anniversary Tuesday of this week.

Surviving are seven children, six daughters and a son, namely Mrs. Charles (Marian) Brockert, Dayton; Paul Ritter, New Bremen; Mrs. Donald (Henrietta) Snider, Minster; Mrs. Grog (Mabel) Gast, New Bremen; Mrs. Paul (Margaret) Pape, New Bremen; Mrs. Harold (Ruth) Ciriegio, Piqua, and Mrs. William (Velma) Stewart, Sidney. There are 18 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Also surviving are three brothers and three sisters, namely John Meyer, Dayton; Mrs. Ella Meyer, Detroit, Mich.; Alex Meyer, Minster; Mrs. Anna Knoetman, Lima; Mrs. Harry Backman, Cincinnati, and Julius Meyer, Minster.

Mrs. Ritter was a member of the St. Monica Sodality of the church.
