Monday for Frances Flisaboth Ritter, aged 74 years, of 45 South Lincoln Street, widow of Joseph Ritter, who died at 10:45 p. m. last week Wednesday in Mercy Hos-pital at Coldwater from effects of a paralytic stroke suffered April 20.
