Requiem high mass will be sung in St. Augustine's Catholic church at 9 a. m. Saturday for Mrs. Clara M. Friemering, aged 72 years and five months, a resident here many years, who died at 12:50 a. m. Tuesday in Piqua Memorial hospital after an extended illness. She was bedfast one week.

Rev. Otto Mueller will be celebrant of the funeral mass, and interment will be made in the church burial ground. Friends may call at the residence of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Huelsman, Sr., up to time of the services.

A native of Newport, Ky., Mrs. Friemering was born July 11, 1877, the daughter of Peter H. and Eleanor Chrisman Mittler. She married Henry Athmer of Minster in 1896, and he died in 1916. She was married a second time, to Fred Friemering of Minster, in 1919. He preceded her in death April 10, 1940.

Surviving are two children, Mrs. Joseph Huelsman, Sr., of here, and Mrs. Ray Warner, New Bremen; four sisters and a brother, Mrs. Louis Schneider of here; Mrs. Orelia Brodersen and Herbert Mittler, both of Phoenix, Ariz., and Mrs. Frances Burger and Mrs. William Roth, both of Delphos; five grandchildren and six great grandchildren. Two children are dead.

Mrs. Friemering was a member of the St. Monica sodality of St. Augustine's church.
