MINISTER - Requiem High Mass will be sung in Sacred Heart Church at nearby McCartyville Thursday at 5 a.m. for Julius F. Otting, 69, who died at 4:30 p.m. Monday in Wilson Memorial Hospital at Sidney from a coronary thrombosis. The Rev. Leo T. Heilbrich will officiate and burial will be in the church cemetery.

Mr. Otting, a longtime employee of the Ross Foundry in Sidney prior to his retirement three years ago, was helping saw wood on the Harris Schroeder farm in the Hardin community when stricken. He was taken to the hospital by automobile and died five minutes after having been admitted.

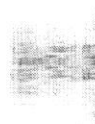
