Mrs. Rosa Sautman, a well known Minister lady, died at her home on south Main street in this city on last Saturday afternoon, July 18, 1936, at 1:30 o'clock. Her death was preceded by an illness protracted over several weeks and the members of her family were prepared to accept the death messenger for many days. She was born in this city and every important incident in connection with her life's affairs had relationship with the social and religious orders here, although she and her parents resided in a distant state for a short period.

She was the widow of the late John Sautman, who also spent many years as a resident here. He passed away at the home where his widow died on last Saturday on May 22, 1933. While in the active pursuits of his life he was connected with the heavy business in Minster and during other periods was engaged in the ministry. He had passed his middle life before he reached the end of his career and besides his wife and his children left a large circle of friends who had been his associates in the civic affairs of the community.

Mrs. Sautman was born in this city October 28, 1866, as the daughter of Frank Puthoff and Elizabeth Frausman Puthoff and the parents were residing in a residence not far from her late home at that time. Both Mr. and Mrs. Puthoff were born in Germany but they came to this country at a very early age and settled here. During the course of Mrs. Sautman's girlhood the family left the city and moved to the state of Arkansas, but they did not

remain in that state long. They returned to Ohio and re-established their home in Minster before the subject of this narrative began her continuous school training.

She began her school work here and her education was received in the schools that were maintained in this city.

Her marriage to Mr. Sautman took place in this city on November 21, 1888, and they established their home in the residence where Mr. Sautman had been born and subsequently where they spent the whole of their married life. Their children were born into this household and two of these persons survive the mother. They are Mrs. Richard Ahns and Alfred Sautman, both residents in this city. Two sons died in infancy.

There are four living grandchildren and the following surviving sisters and brothers: Mrs. Cynthia Raver, Mrs. Kate Zoll in California; Mrs. Anna Gardner, Mrs. Pauline St. Gohin, Mrs. Josephine Wetherbee at Coldwater; John Puthoff at Niles, Michigan; Fred Puthoff at Rock River, Wyoming.


One brother, who was Louis Puthoff, met a violent death at St. Henry, Ohio, several years ago.

The deceased was a life time member of the St. Augustine parish and she was also identified with the St. Monica ladies auxiliary.

The funeral was held on Tuesday morning at the church in this city and the remains were given interment in the local cemetery.


