Funeral services for Dr. Clarence Rawers, M.D., 54, father of Dr. Robert Rawers, Tiffin pediatrician, will be held at Chickasaw, Mercer County, Monday, August 8, 1955. Burial will be in Mercer County.



Body of Clarence B. Rawers, who died last Thursday morning in Cleveland, was returned to Chickssaw, where he formerly lived, for funeral services and burial. Requiem mass was sung in Precious Blood church Monday morning and burial was made in the church cometery.
