Funeral services for Dr. Clarence Rawers, M.D., 54, father of Dr. Robert Rawers, Tiffin pediatrician, will be held at Chickasaw, Mercer County, Monday, August 8, 1955. Burial will be in Mercer County.

Dr. Rawers, who had been practicing in Bergholz, Jefferson County, died Wednesday evening, August 3, 1955 in Crile Veterans Administration Hospital, Cleveland, where he had been a patient for several months. He served in World War II.

Included among his survivors, in addition to the son here, is another son, Capt. James Rawers, U.S. Air Force of Washington D.C. and a daughter, Mrs. Betty Swanke of Albuquerque, N. Mex. Caption Rawers came to Tiffin from Washington and the two sons were in Coldwater to make final arrangements. The body is at Desch Funeral Home in Coldwater.

Chickasaw Native's Body Returned There

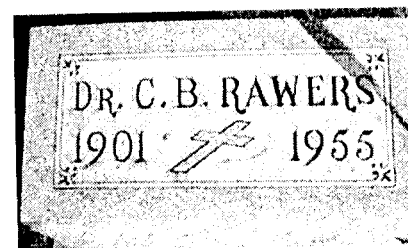
Body of Clarence B. Rawers, who died last Thursday morning in Cleveland, was returned to Chickasaw, where he formerly lived, for funeral services and burial. Requiem mass was sung in Precious Blood church Monday morning and burial was made in the church cemetery.

Dr. Rawers' death was attributed to cancer of the brain for which he had undergone surgery. He was a native of Chickasaw and a son of Dr. and Mrs. H. G. Rawers. He was graduated from Ohio State university school of medicine.

He is survived by three children, Dr. Robert Rawers of Tiffin, Capt. James Rawers of the air force and Betty Jane of Albuquerque, N. M., and brothers and sisters: Arthur Rawers, an attorney in Lyons, Ill., C. L. Rawers of Chickasaw, Bert Rawers of Dayton, Marco Rawers of Los Angeles, Calif., Dr. A. J. Rawers of Celina, Mrs. Georgianna Morris of Dunkirk, Ind., and Mrs. Salome Frieburger of Van Wert.
