MINSTER - Charlotte M. "Shorty" Borchers, 91, formerly of N. Lincoln St., Minster, died Friday, Oct. 22, 2010, at 10 a.m. at Heritage Manor Nursing Center, Minster. She had been a resident there for four years.

She was born on Oct. 27, 1918, in Chickasaw, to August and Mathilda (Rentz) Niekamp, and they preceded her in death.

She was first married to Leo F. Rutschilling, and he died Aug. 3, 1971. Her second marriage was to Clarence Borchers, and he died Aug. 19, 1996.

She is survived by her daughter, Liz (Rutschilling) McDermitt and her husband, Monty McDermitt, of Minster; and by a sister-in-law, Grace Niekamp, of Minster.

She was preceded in death by two brothers, Homer and Morris "Bud" Niekamp; and a sister, Beulah Knapke.

Shorty was a member of St. Augustine Catholic Church, Minster, and a member of the women's church choir. She enjoyed playing cards and quilting. She was employed as a waitress at the Wooden Shoe Inn in Minster for 20 years and also worked at The Post Printing and Wagners IGA.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10 a.m. on Tuesday in St. Augustine Church, with the Rev. Rick Nieberding officiating. Burial will follow at St. Augustine Cemetery.


