Osgood native Herbert H. Schlater, 85, 128 Woodhaven Drive, Sidney, died of cancer at 4:15 p.m. June 25, 2004, at his home. He was born May 23, 1919 in Osgood, to Fred and Bernadine Albers Schlater.

Surviving with his wife of 59 years, the former Antoinette Streacker of Maria Stein, are four sons: Kenneth (Brenda) of Sidney, William (Elizabeth) of Cincinnati, John (Debra) of Columbus and James (Karen) of Brookfield, Wis.; two daughters: Janice (Nicholas) Sharkey, Northville, Mich. and Sharon (John) Rittenhouse, Plymouth, Mich.; two brothers: Norb (Vera) of Versailles and Elmer (Carol) of Sidney; three sisters: Delores (Robert) Peltier, Russia, Velma (Jiggs) Thobe, Maria Stein, and Marlene (Joseph) Crusey, Sidney; two sisters-in-law: Norma Schlater, Fort Loramie, and Martha (Cy) Thobe, Chickasaw; 23 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Deceased are three brothers: Al, Vernon and Urban; a sister, Alma; and a sister-in-law, Lucille Schlater.

Following military service with the Army Air Corps during World War II, he worked at Anderson Electric Company in Sidney from 1946 to 1953, when he founded Sidney Electric Company and served as president until his retirement in 1984. He also founded Fair Inc., a real estate development company, in 1976 and served as chairman of Bank One Sidney N.A. board of directors from 1975 to 1989

He was the first board of education president at Lehman Catholic High School, founder of the Lehman Foundation, chairman of the school's 1985 building committee. He started the Sidney Electric Girls Softball League, was a founding member of Shelby Oaks Golf Club, was a member of the Wilson Memorial Hospital Board of trustees and served on numerous local boards and charities.

Funeral Mass is 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at the church Burial will follow at Graceland Cemetery.

Calling is 2-8 p.m. Tuesday in the Schlater Family Gymnasium at Lehman Catholic High School. Sidney, and 9-10 a.m. Wednesday at Cromes Funeral Home, also of Sidney.
