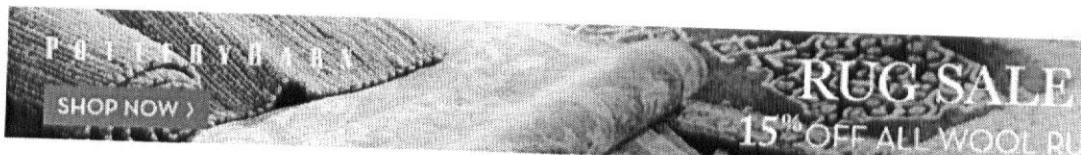

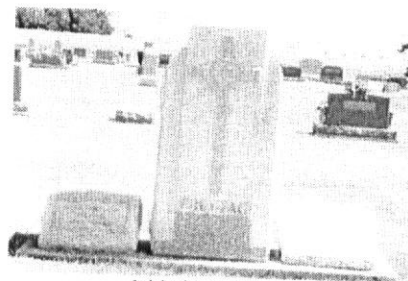

MRS. FREYTAG

Having suffered a stroke, a week ago Wednesday, Mrs. Karl (Marie Christine Schmidt) Freytag, 82, died at her home in Ft. Loramie, Sunday morning early, and funeral services were held yesterday morning at 10:00 o'clock in the Zion church here of which the decedent had been an almost lifelong member, the Rev. N. E. Vitz officiating, and burial followed in the Schwaberow cemetery, east of New Bremen.

Born March 10, 1862, in Wulverstedt, Germany, Mrs. Freytag as a small child came with her parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. Ernst Schmidt, to America, the family at first settling in the state of Texas, but in 1892 they came to this section of Ohio, establishing their home in Fort Loramie, where on January 3, 1896, she married Karl Freytag, who now survives together with seven adult children. The latter are Mrs. Harry (Bertha) Chase, Toledo; Miss Hermina Freytag, at home; Mrs. Eugene (Pauline) Bemus and Ford Freytag, Sidney; Louis Freytag, Columbus; Edward and Herman Freytag, Ft. Loramie. There are also 21 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Freytag was well known in New Bremen, a devout member of the Zion Evangelical and Reformed church where she attended regularly throughout the years and made friends with members and others whom she learned to know by these frequent visits. [NB Sun-7/27/1944]
