Train Kills Widow On Celina Tracks

Freight at 5:10 p.m. Engineer E. H. Danavos of Lima said the train was traveling 20 to 25 miles per hour at that time. Fireman John Tennally, also of Lima, reported he pointed the horn repeatedly when he saw Mrs. Schoch standing about 10 feet from the track. Dr. Donald Fox, Mercer County coroner, said death was due to severe brain lacerations. Celina police conducted the investigation.

Funeral High Mass will be offered 10:30 a.m. Thursday in Immaculate Conception Catholic Church by Rev. Charles Brecht. Burial will be in the church cemetery.

Born July 12, 1891, in Celina, Mrs. Schoch was the daughter of John and Catherine Romer Beckman. She was married to Willibald Schoch, who died in December.

A member of Immaculate Conception Church, she is survived by four nephews: Gene and Warren Beckman of Cincinnati; Paul of Loyola University, Detroit; and Robert, a missionary in Arica, Peru; and two nieces, Catherine Marlow of Canton and Irene Lorraine of Cincinnati.
