Edward Sommer, aged 64, a native and former resident of Minster, died at 4 p. m. Tuesday in Gibbons Hospital at Celina, in which city he had resided many years. Mr. Sommer had been in failing health two and a half years. He was admitted to the hospital Monday morning. Death was attributed to a heart attack.

Mr. Sommer, upon establishing residence in Celina, was associated with the former Brandts Furniture Company for 25 years. When this firm discontinued operations he became associated with the Celina Stearic Acid Company. He retired about six months age because of failing health. He was a World War I vetoran.

Surviving are his wife, Pearl (Grogean) Sommer, whom he married 29 years ago; a son, David, of Dayton; a daughter, Mrs. Joseph (Jane) Moeder, Celina; five grandchildren; a brother, Frank, Celina; two sisters, Mrs. Frank Dine of Colina and Mrs. Anton Donauer of Minster.

Mr. Sommer was a member of the Immatulate Conception Clurch in Celina and held membership in the American Legica tuere.

Solemn Requiem High Mass will be sung in the church at 9:30 a. m. Friday with the Rev. Richard Beischel as celebrant. Burial will be in the church cemetery.


