Bernard Vanderberet, aged 97, familiarly known as Barnsy, died at 18:30 s. m. Monday in the residence of Mr. and Mrs. John Concaughton, 156 North Main Street, with whom he had resided for a long period. He was Minster's oldest resident.

lifetime Minsterite, would have observed his 98th birthday Oct. 12. He was born in 1858 and followed the trade of plasterer for many years. He had been an invalid several years

as result of amputation of a leg and fading eyesight.

Death occurred unexpectedly as Mr. Vanderhorst sat in his wheel chair, and presumably re-sulted from heart failure. Mrs. Connaughton, his granddaugh-ter, saw him slump in the chair and a physician pronounced

and a physician pronounced him dead a short time later. Mr. Vanderhorst and Anna Vallo were married Sept. 28, 1880 and she died June 23, 1948. Survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Fred Hanselman of Dayton, six grandchildren, seven great grand-children and a great-great grand-child. He was a member of the old Cataract Fire Company.

Requiem High Mass was sung at 9 s. m. Wednesday in St. Augustine's Church by the Roy. William Meyer. Interment fol-lowed in the church burial ground. Arrangements were in charge of the Hogenkamp Funeral Home.


