ber 11th at 6 a. m. He had been sick since Monday, Oct. 7th. He was uttacked so intensely that the best care and medical treatment

proved without avail.

Mr. Vanderhorst was the son of Mr. Barney Vanderhorstand wife Anna nee Vallo and was born here in Minster, May 7th 1888. He grew up in this town and learned the plasterer's trade. On October 23, 1907, he was narried to Miss Anna Murphy, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. R. Murphy of here. This marriage was blessed with three children i. e. Jola 10, Vivian 8, and Laura 5 years old, who with his wife are left to mourn his untimely death. The deceased reached the age of 30 years, 5 months and 4 days.

He is also survived by one sister, Mrs. Laura Schelper of New Bremen.

The deceased was known for his humorous disposition and always showing a friendly disposition towards everybody. He was well known and well liked.

The burial took place Monday, October 14th, at Lock Two, Rev. Henninger of New Bremen officiat-

ing.

HARRY (HAPPY HOOLIGAN)
VANDERHORST — KNOWN FOR
DISPOSITION AND HARMLESS
PLEASANTRY


Harry (Happy Hooligan) Vander-homt, 26, died last night at his place of residence in Hinster. The cause of the fatality is unreported. Surviving are the wife and three little daughters, in addition to a numerous relationship. The title "Happy Hooligan" was bestowed on Mr. Vander-horst because of his jocular temperameist and tendency toward harmless-pleasantry. As a village character he was among the widely known citizens of the town.

Harry Vanderhorst was married to Anna Mae Murphy. Their 3 daughters were lola Neldemire, Vivian Connaughton, & Laura ("Babe") Smith. He is said to have died in the flu epidemic and is buried at German Protestant Cemetery in grave P-08-5 in the North Addition, which was purchased 10/12/1918 by Barney Vanderhorst. The dates on his tombstone are 1888-1919. He was the son of Bernard J. & Anna (Vallo) Vanderhorst. His wife is buried in Greentawn Cemetery in Wapakoneta. A sister, Laura Vanderhorst, married Henry Schelper.


