Daughter of Rudolph and Philomena Sutmann Wempe. She married Joseph Steinke on 11 Aug 1874. She had eleven children. The first five being Mary Anna, Carolina Josephine, Rudolph Albert, William Fredrick, and Casper George. The sixth, Joseph was born Christmas of 1885. He died 12 Jul 1887 when his Philomena was 4 months pregnant. That child turned out to be a girl, Helena Anna. Followed by a boy, Edward Leo. In the next five years she had her final three children, Catherine Cecelia, Clement Michael, and Lauretta Philomena Gertrude. Catherine died at age 17 of heart disease, and Lauretta at age 21 after eating poisonous cranberries contributed too by typhoid fever.

She died at 4:30 PM March 26th 1937 of
 myocarditis.
 She was burried March 31st.
