oncology in Mount Vernon for 35 years, from 1966 to 2001. During his career, Bob remained very active in the field of cancer treatment and research and was a member of the American Cancer Society - Ohio Chapter, eventually serving one year as president. A Mass of Christian burial will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, 303 E. High St., Mount Vernon, Ohio, 43050, with the Rev. Mark J. Hammond officiating. Burial will be in Mount Calvary Catholic Cemetery.
