Aged Lady Dead

Mrs. Therese Tebbe died on Monday evening at McCartyville following a stroke of paralysis which overtook her on Sunday evening at 6:00 o'clock. She was born in Auldinburg, Germany, in the year of 1843 and lived in that country until she had attained the age of twelve years, when, in company with her parents, she came to America. As a growing girl her time was spent in the city of Cincinnati and she continued to live in that place until about the time of her marriage to Frank Tebbe in the year of 1865.

Following their marriage they moved to Shelby county and located on a farm east of Ft. Loramie where the subject of this sketch spent a large portion of her life. Her husband died forty-six years ago but she continued to make her home at their farm place until sixteen years ago when she moved into the village of Fort Loramie. She remained a resident there until about three and one-half years ago when on account of failing health she decided to make a change in her manner of living and established herself in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Chas. Koverman at McCartyville. She died at his home. Her age at the time of her death was 79 years, 10 months and 15 days.

She is survived by the following near relatives: Sons Joseph, John and Bernard Tebbe; daughters Mary Luthman, Elizabeth Hausfeld and Josephine Koverman; thirty grand children and 13 great-grand children.

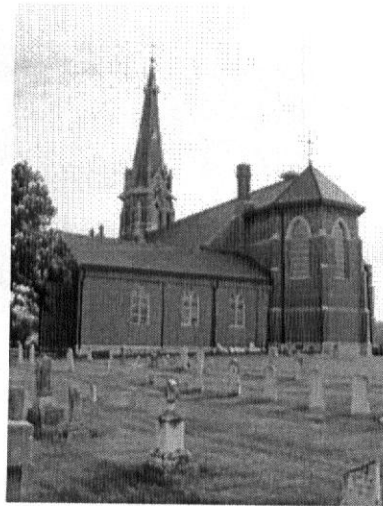
