She was born in Auklinburg, Germany, in the year of 1843 and lived in that the year of 1843 and lived in that country until she had attained the age of twelve years, when, in company with her parents, she came to America. As a growing girl her time was spent in the city of Cinchunati and she continued to live in that place until about the live in that place until about the

hve in that place until about the time of her marriage to Frank Tebbe in the year of 1865.

Following their marriage they moved to shelby county and located on a farm cust of Ft. Loranic where the subject of this sketch spent a large portion of her life. Her lusband died forty-six years ago but she continued to make her ago but she continued to make her home at their farm place until home at their farm place until sixteen years ago when she moved into the village of Fort Loramic. She remained a resident there until about three and one-half years ago when on account of failing health she decided to make a change in her manner of living and established herself in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Chas. Koverman at McCartyville. She died at his home. Her age at the time of her death was 79 years, 10 months and 15 days.




