

Harold F. Barhorst

Harold F. Barhorst, 77, died at 9:30 a.m. Monday, July 17, 2006, at the Versailles Health Care Center in Versailles. He had formerly lived on East Sixth Street in Minster.

He was born Sept. 9, 1928, in Fort Loramie to Albert and Anna (Barlage) Barhorst, who are deceased. Two brother-in-laws, Orville Mangen and Vernon Vondenhuevel also preceded him in death.
