C. Don Burget, 73, of Celina, died Saturday, June 28, 2008, at Mercer Health Community Hospital in Coldwater.

He was born to Mary (Wheatley) and Dale Burget on May 22, 1935, in Prairie Township, in Tipton County, Ind. He was better known to many as "Boss" Burget in the community.

He graduated from Prairie Township High School in 1953, and his employment included Perfect Circle Corp., later known as Dana Corp., and he later became a staff representative in District 30 of the United Steel Workers Union. He lived in Kokomo, Elkhart, Ind., and Celina, later retiring in Celina.

He is survived by three sisters: Marianna (Don) Gray of Tipton, Ind., Madonna (John) Spratt of Las Brisas, Honduras and Marilyn (Danny) Nash of Prairie Township, as well as a very special friend Mary McClain, of Celina. He was preceded in death by his parents and brother Gerald E. Burget.

His memberships included Eagles and Moose Lodges in Celina, a 50-year member of the Austin Masonic Lodge 128 F and AM and Elk's BPOE 1012 in Tipton, Ind.
