Funeral services were held in St. Augustine's church Tues-day morning for Mrs. Elizabeth Mary Stueve, aged 77 years and nine months, who died shortly before 11 a. m. Saturday in the family residence, 103 South Cleveland street, after an extended illness

Requiem high mass for the aged woman, who incurred a broken hip in a fall last Aug. 3 and was confined to bed from then until her death, was offered by the Rev. Otto Mueller. Interment was made in the

church burial ground.


A lifelong Minsterite, Mrs.
