

Decedent Worked As Janitor Of Minster Schools For 30 Years

Funeral services were held in the St. Augustine church at \$30 a. m. Wednesday for Wil-iam C. Buschman, aged 61 gars and five months, lifelong Minster community resident, who died in his home at 256 North Frankfort street at 5:50
