

Rev. David Dougherty

Rev. David Dougherty, C.P.P.S., 83, a member of the Kansas City Province of the Society of the Precious Blood, died Tuesday, August 15, 2006 at St. Charles Center in Carthagen, where he had resided since 2002.

Rev. Dougherty was born November 27, 1922 in Dodge City, Kansas to Joseph and Nellie (Dollison) Dougherty. He was incorporated into the Society of the Precious Blood on December 8, 1944 and was ordained a priest on March 25, 1949. His assignments included parishes in Ohio, Kansas, Minnesota, Iowa and Missouri.

Reception of the body will be at 12:35 p.m. with a prayer vigil at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, August 18, 2006 at St. Charles Center in Carthagen. The Mass of the Resurrection will be held at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, August 19, 2006 in Assumption Chapel at St. Charles Center with burial to follow in the Community cemetery.

Rev. Dougherty was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Thomas Dougherty and Robert Barker. Survivors include his brothers, Joseph and Bernard Dougherty, and one sister, Margaret Clawson.
