Jean Claude & Josephine (Bouillon) Francis were pioneer residents of Loramie Township in Shelby County, Ohio. They were natives of Alsace and left France for America on Christmas day, 1851, arriving in New Orleans, Louisiana on January 29, 1852. They traveled from there by steamboat up the Mississippi River to Cincinnati, and then to Piqua via the (Miami & Erie) Canal in a canal boat drawn by mules. When they got to Piqua, they were taken by oxen to the southwest corner of Loramie Township, where they resided until their deaths. They had 9 sons, of which one died young. 
