



Mrs. Mary Matilda Olding, wife of Peter Olding, was claimed in death at 12:30 a. m. Thursday at her residence on North Frankfort street in Minster, concluding an illness of four months' duration during which she was confined to bed three months. Death was attributed to a kidney ailment. She would have observed her 66th birthday next Feb. 12.

Funeral services will be conducted in St. Augustine's church at 10:30 a. m. Saturday. Requiem high mass will be celebrated by the Rev. Emil Schuway. Interment will be made in the church burial ground.


Mrs. Olding was born in Shelby county to Bernard and Josephine Drees, on Feb. 12, 1884. She married John Frericks in November of 1908 and his death occurred in March, 1924. Her marriage to Mr. Olding took place Nov. 25, 1943.

Surviving in addition to the husband are six children, Asta Gauvey, Van Wert; Miss Cornelia Frericks, Dayton; Frank, Clifford, Robert and Roger Frericks of here; five stepchildren, Leo and Miss Hilda Frericks, Minster; Miss Rose Frericks, Van Wert; John Frericks, Delphos and Mrs. Mary Kirsch, Troy; 10 grandchildren; a sister, Mrs. Bernadine Henke, Ft. Loramie, and four brothers, Joseph and John Drees of Ft. Loramie, Ben of Coldwater and Anton of Osgood. There also are four stepdaughters and three stepsons, the children of Peter Olding.

Mrs. Olding held membership in the St. Monica sodality of the church and of the Veterans of Foreign Wars auxiliary here.
