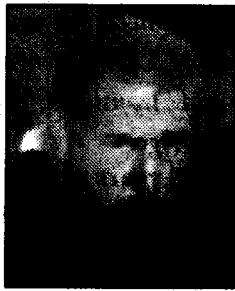


Ronald A. Gaier
