Dr. Richard P. Harbord, 93, of New Knoxville, died at 12:59 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2005, at St. Rita's Medical Center in Lima.

He was born Nov. 30, 1911, in Hull, Yorkshire, England, a son of Commander Arthur and Gladys (Penn) Harbord.
