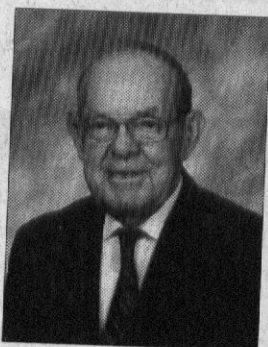


Paul F. Hoying

Paul F. Hoying, formerly of Minster, died on Wednesday, May 28, 2008, at Wilson Hospital in Sidney. He was 85 years old.
