

# Robert B. Huelskamp

Robert Bernard Huelskamp, 77, of Georgetown, Texas passed away on Sunday, Dec. 19, 2010.

Robert was born May 30, 1933 in Minster, to the late Raymond Peter and Eleanorea Elizabeth Watercutter Huelskamp.

Robert was raised in the Minster area most of his life, graduating from Minster High School in 1951. While in high school, he participated in several sports and excelled at all of them. He was the captain of the football team, the baseball team and the basketball team. Robert was known in the Minster area for scoring the first touchdown ever for Minster High School.

Robert graduated from the University of Dayton in 1955 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting. He went on to become a CPA. Robert served his country in the U.S. Army from 1956 to 1958.

Robert married the love of his life, Janet Margaret Albers in Minster, on Oct. 26, 1957. They lived in Dayton, raising their family, and building their life together until 2001, when they moved to Sun City in Georgetown, Texas. While in Dayton, they were members of the St. Charles Catholic Church. Robert served as a Eucharistic Minister.

In 1958, Robert began his career as a CPA, and in 1962 he became a partner in the accounting firm of Henz, Hawk and Huelskamp, Inc. He retired in 2000 after more than 40 years as a CPA. He was a long time member of the Ohio Society of CPAs. Upon moving to Georgetown, Robert did not stop serving his community. He and Janet joined St. Helen's Catholic Church and he served as Eucharistic Minister and worked with the homebound. He was a longtime member of the Knights of Columbus and the Kiwanis Club. Robert loved to help others. He became a mentor for the Georgetown Independent School District and worked with children at Birkman Elementary and Benott Middle School. He was named "Mentor of the Year," in 2009. Robert enjoyed spending time with family and friends, playing tennis, square dancing, golfing, and playing cards.

Robert leaves behind to cherish his memory his loving wife of more than 53 years, Janet M. Huelskamp; daughters, Kay Overholser and her husband, Randy of Monroe, Wash., Christine Rainbolt and her husband Rocky of Plano, Texas and Susan Longley of Euless, Texas; siblings, Virgil Huelskamp and his wife Lee of Carpentaria, Calif., Shirley Rell and her husband Conrad of Blythe, Ga.; brother-in-law, Father Thomas Albers, CPPS; and grandchildren, Travis Overholser, Casey Overholser and his wife Shelby, Brittany Overholser and Alex Rainbolt along with numerous other loving family members and friends.

He is also preceded in death by a son-in-law, Robert Longley.
