Death claimed an esteemed young wife at 3:10 a. m. Tuesday when Mrs. Elvera (Knostman) Lehmann, aged 33 years, wife of Martin Lehmann, succumbed in the home of her father and stepmother, Mr. and Mrs. Louis Knostman, at 39 North Main street in Minster. Complications were blamed for her passing.

Although she had been failing for a period of about two years, Mrs. Lehmann had not been ill recently. She came to Minster with her husband for a visit after having spent some time with relatives in West Virginia. She became seriously ill while here, and was bedfast for seven weeks.

Mr. and Mrs. Lehmann decided on taking a vacation trip after he disposed of a garage business which he had operated in Piqua for a number of years, intending to enter the service of the federal government at Dayton.

Born on Aug. 21, 1907 in Minster, she was a daughter of Louis and the late Pearl (Ley) Knostman. She grew to womanhood here, and on Aug. 21, 1927 she was married in Holy Angels church at Sidney to Mr. Lehmann. The couple established their home in Piqua immediately after their marriage. They resided at 210 East North street in that city.

Mrs. Lehmann was a lifelong Catholic, and departed this life fortified with the last sacrament of the church. She was a member of St. Mary's church at Piqua, and was enrolled in the St. Margaret Ladies' Auxiliary of the Knights of St. John there.

Serviving in addition to the husband and the father and stepmother, are a brother Donald of Minster and a sister, Mrs. Evelyn Mehmert of Huntington, W. Va. A son Robert preceded her in death in 1928 at the age of nine months, and a brother Elmer died in 1933.

Funeral services have been arranged for Friday at 9 a. m. in St. Augustine's church. Rev. Theodore Koenn will officiate. Interment will be made in the parish burial ground.
