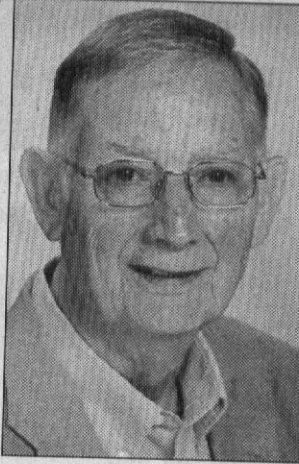


Paul U. Moorman

Paul U. Moorman, 82, of Minster, died Jan. 3, 2006 at Dayton Heart Hospital following a two-week illness.

Born July 6, 1923 in Maria Stein, he was the son of Frank and Johanna (Luebke) Moorman. On Oct. 26, 1946, he



married Donna Gudorf in Minster.

the Minster Historical Society. He was an Army Aircorps veteran, having served in World War II in Africa and Italy as a technical sergeant. He was a retired co-owner of Gudorf and Moorman in Minster, worked at Joint Township Hospital operations with the Village of Minster.

A funeral was held Jan. 10 at St. Augustine Catholic Church in Minster with the Rev. Rick Nieberding presiding and burial with full military honors following at St. Augustine Cemetery.
