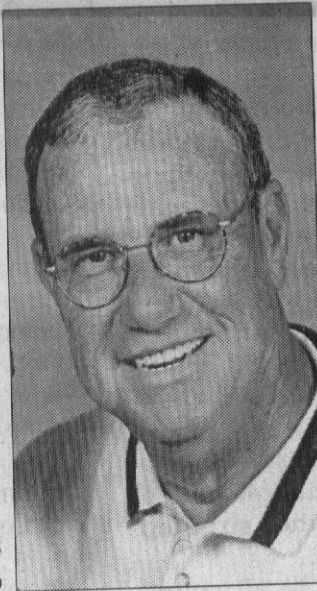


## John N. Mueller
