Donald J. Oldiges, 75, of Minster, died at 2 a.m., Monday, August 13, 2007, at St. Rita's Medical Center in Lima, following a one day illness.

He was born Oct. 27, 1931, in Minster, a son of Edward and Margaret (Brunnegraf) Oldiges, and they preceded him in death.

On Oct. 16, 1957, he married Nancy Ruby in Sidney, and she survives him.
